Welcome to Western Riverina Community College for 2020. Over the past years, I have called on our community to act and become engaged in College activities. In calling out to you, my motivations centre on improving our community through the provision of education, which in turn supports your aspirations to become the best version of you.

So, you might ask; how have you got on with that? The answer to this question is not readily visible. In this sense, change in people is not always instantly obvious. However, WRCC considers student participation and positive learning outcomes as a way of answering that question. That is, enrolments, participation and outcomes paint a picture of positive learning activity that is deep and broad.

And where's the evidence? In our participation results. Over 90% of WRCC students achieve and complete their intended learning outcome and are happy with the quality of the training they receive. Many move into the workforce or higher levels of employment or undertake further education as a result of participation in a WRCC course.

Satisfaction has seen WRCC's numbers grow, with client growth exceeding 10% each year for the past three years and student numbers growing over 37% over the same time. This student growth has provided an additional 800 students to the College. What's even more staggering is that, on average, each individual student participated in three separate learning activities bringing over 27,000 total enrolments from 2016-2019.

As I stated earlier, evidence of participation and learning are often hard to see. Nevertheless, I can confidently state that WRCC continues to build, strengthen and reduce barriers in our community through the provision of education. That is our purpose.

I hope to see you all at the College soon and trust we can help you and our community with your learning needs in 2020.
